**Sports Facilities**

There is a football pitch on the residence site. There are also an indoor swimming pool, tennis courts, indoor sports hall and playing fields at the King's School Sports Centre within easy reach of the residence.

**Classes**

Most classes take place in the cathedral grounds of The King's School. The cathedral grounds are five minutes' walk from the St. Augustine's Site. Some classes will also take place in rooms on the St. Augustine's Site.

**Meals**

All meals are taken in The Refectory in the cathedral grounds, or in the Undercroft on the St. Augustine's Site.

**Afternoon and Evening Activities**

There is a minimum of 11 activities per week including; discos, film nights, karaoke, football, tennis, basketball, swimming, cinema, bowling, student nights, shopping, local attractions such as visiting Canterbury Cathedral or boating on The Stour.

**Excursions**
