- Under UK law, all students under the age of 18 are classed as children, and there are certain laws and school rules concerning what your child can or cannot do in the UK. For example, children under the age of 16 must be home by 22.00 each night; if they leave their home after dark they must inform their host family where they are going; they must not enter a pub or club; they must not drink alcohol, smoke cigarettes or take illegal drugs.
- We will work hard to ensure that your child is happy and improves their English during their stay with us, and we ask you to read the following information carefully and to sign the two forms in the appropriate sections.

If your child visits a friend/relative they must have the school's permission and they must inform the school and host family of their travel plans and who they are going to visit. The friend/relative must collect your child and return them to the homestay.

Please note:

- Your child will study in classes with students aged 18 and over
- Your child will travel between the school and the host family unsupervised.
- Your child will not be supervised during their free time, e.g. between the end of their lessons at the school and returning to their homestay
- Your child must attend all classes. The school has a strict attendance policy. Students can be absent only if they are unwell. In such cases, the student or their host family must telephone the school as soon as possible on the day of the illness.
- The school's social programme is not compulsory, nor is it specifically designed for this age group. Certain activities are not suitable for students under 18. All school social activities are supervised by school staff who can assist the students attending the activity. We strongly advise all students to return to their host family with a

friend, or preferably by taxi, particularly in the evening when it is dark. You can see examples of the social programme on our web site at <http://www.stgiles-international.com/student-services/leisure/>

- The school takes bookings for full-day trips on Saturdays and Sundays. These are organised by an external company and no St Giles staff go on the trips. The company the school uses does not allow under-16s to participate in the trips.
- You should ensure that your child has sufficient money to pay for lunches at the school, and for transportation in Eastbourne. For guidance, £5 per day should be sufficient for lunch and drinks in the school canteen, and a typical taxi fare is currently £6 per journey, approximately. - All students under the age of 16 **MUST** have a return airport taxi transfer, unless they are travelling with a named relative.
- Many airlines require children under the age of 16 to be escorted to the check-in desk at the airport on their return home. Please check if this is a requirement of your child's airline. We can arrange an assisted check-in – please contact the school office for further information.
- The school reserves the right to terminate the course of any student who seriously or persistently misconducts himself/herself during his/her stay
