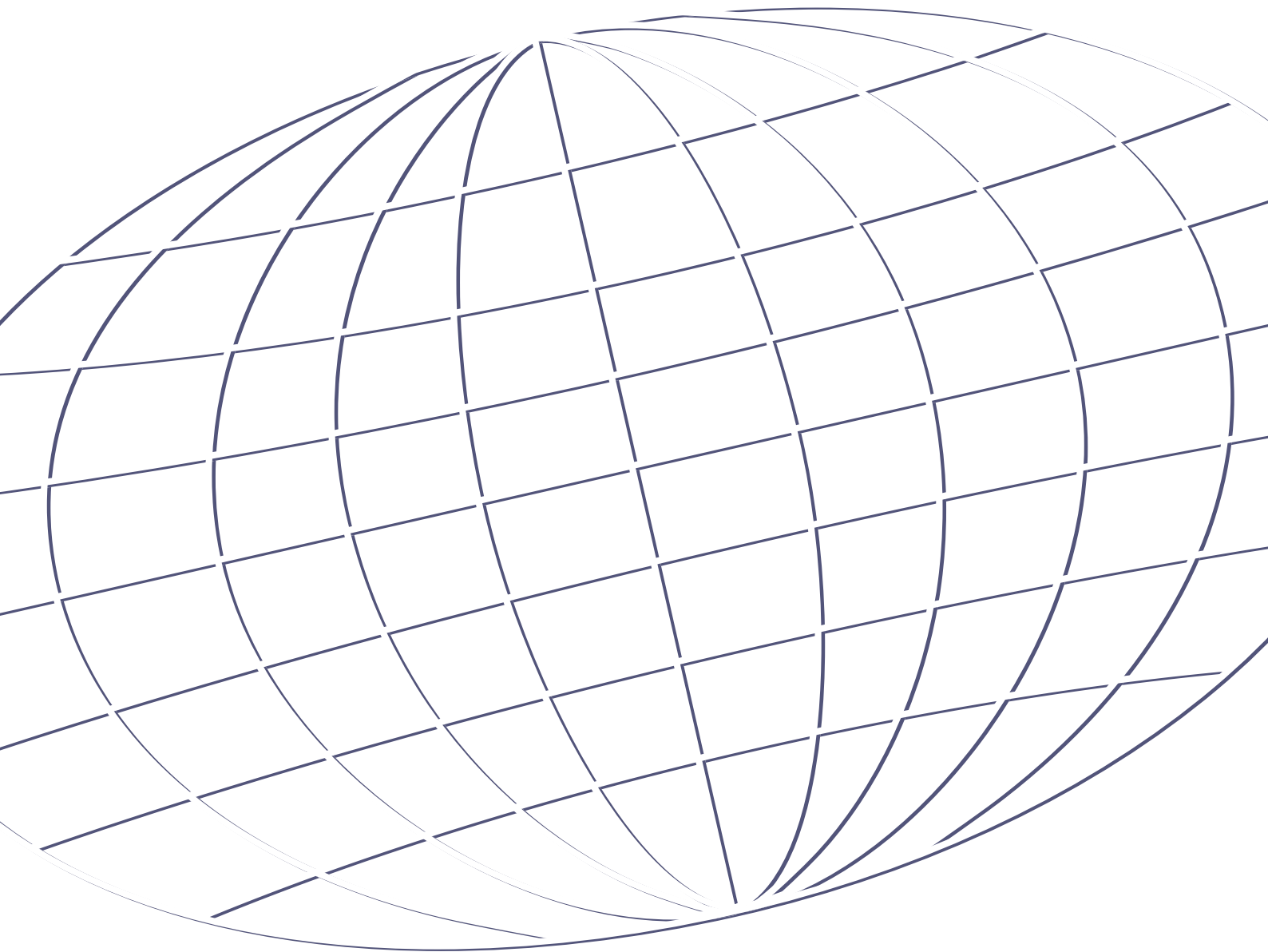

Important Information – Adult Courses

Tuition dates:

There are no classes on Saturdays and Sundays, nor on the following public holidays:
