To help you to prepare for your stay in Vancouver we have put together a 'cost of living' guide. This should help you to estimate how much money you will need to bring to Canada with you. All prices are in Canadian Dollars. We look forward to welcoming you to St Giles Vancouver!

## Entertainment / Social Programme

St Giles Vancouver offers a social programme to help you make the most of your time in Vancouver. Some activities, such as a movie night at the school and soccer in the park, will be free. Others will have a small charge, such as bowling, ice skating or bubble tea. You can also go on weekend trips. A guide is included below. If you take part in one day weekend trip and 3 evening activities a week (including some free events) you should expect to spend about $\$ 100$ (not including drinks at a pub night).

## Public transport

Here are some prices for travelling in and around Vancouver. Vancouver now uses a reloadable transit card called COMPASS.

The Metro Vancouver is divided into "zones". There are three fare zones and the number of zone boundaries you cross during your trip will determine your fare. Weekdays after 6:30 pm and all day Saturday, Sunday and holidays, you may travel anywhere in Vancouver for a 1 zone price. Monthly Passes are valid only from the first day to the last day of the month. You choose MONTHLY PASS at the COMPASS terminals when loading your card. COMPASS CARD is good for buses, SKYTRAIN, and SEABUS.

Buses are a 1-Zone fare, all day, every day. Cash fares on buses are not transferable to SkyTrain, West Coast Express, or SeaBus.

Please note that you will receive a $10 \%$ discount on all course books purchased at St Giles. Sometimes we have used books for sale and rentals available for short stays.
