

How to travel from the Airports and Ports to St Giles Brighton

Your journey time and cost, from the UK airport of arrival to your accommodation in Brighton, will vary depending on the airport and your address in Brighton.

We can arrange airport transfers from all the main airports and from St Pancras Station but if you prefer to travel by public transport these are the main options you can choose from:

HEATHROW

Travel by National Express bus direct from the Central Bus Station at Heathrow to Brighton Coach Station. The journey takes about 2h40 and costs between £21 and £31, depending on the time of day.

Travel by Underground and Mainline trains is not recommended because 2 changes are necessary. The journey would take about 2h30 and cost £34.70 - £52.70.

GATWICK

From here you can take a mainline train direct to Brighton. The journey will take about 35 minutes and cost between £9.30 and £14, depending on the time of day. No changes are necessary.

Travel by National Express bus from the airport to Brighton Coach Station. The journey will take about 45 minutes and cost approximately £10.

LUTON

From here you can take a mainline train directly to Brighton. This will cost between £35 and £46 and the journey will take approximately 2h30.

You can also travel by National Express bus but you will need to change buses in London. The journey will take 4 and a half hours and tickets will cost between £38 and £50, depending on the time of day.

STANSTED

You can travel by National Express bus direct from Stansted airport to Brighton Coach Station. The journey takes between 4 and 5 hours and tickets cost between £21 and £40, depending on the time of day.

Travel by train is not recommended because 2 changes are necessary. The journey would take about 2 and a half hour and cost £55.

LONDON CITY

You can travel by train from London City airport to Brighton Station. The journey will take nearly 3 hours and cost about £45.00. You will need to change trains 4 times on this journey.

ST PANCRAS (Eurostar):

You can travel by train direct from St Pancras to Brighton. The journey takes about 1 hour 40 minutes and currently costs between £20 - £26.

There are no buses direct from St Pancras to Brighton.

NEWHAVEN FERRY TERMINAL

You can travel from Newhaven to Brighton by either bus or train but we would not recommend this if you are arriving with luggage as it is a 17 minute walk from the ferry terminal to both the train station and the bus stop.

If you do arrive at Newhaven, you will walk 17 minutes to Newhaven Harbour Train Station. Here you can take a train direct to Brighton or catch a bus direct to Brighton.

Trains leave every 30 minutes and the journey takes approximately 30 minutes. A single adult ticket will cost £4.60.

Buses leave every 15-20 minutes from outside the train station. The journey by bus will take approximately 1 hour and a single adult ticket will cost £7.
