

How to travel from the Airport to St Giles North American Centres

All our centres in North America offer an airport transfer service for students. You may however prefer to travel by public transport, and the information below can help you to do this.

St Giles San Francisco

Your journey will depend on the location of your accommodation. Once you have booked accommodation with us, the school office can give you details to help you plan your journey.

From San Francisco International airport, you can take a BART (Bay Area Rapid Transport) train which services both downtown San Francisco and many of the neighbourhoods where our host families are located.

New York City

Your journey time and cost from the airport will vary depending on where your accommodation is. Once you have booked your course and accommodation, our office will advise you about the location of your accommodation so you can plan your journey there from the airport. Below are the main routes into Manhattan from the main airports:

JFK Airport: From JFK Airport you can take the AirTrain to Penn Station in Manhattan. From there you can take a subway or a bus to your accommodation. Most places in Manhattan are reachable in about an hour using these public transportation routes.

Newark: From Newark Airport you can take an AirTrain to Penn Station in Manhattan, which will take about 45 minutes. From there you can take a subway or bus to your accommodation.

La Guardia: New York City buses provide an 'NYC Airporter' service between LaGuardia and Manhattan, where you can then take a subway to your accommodation. It is also possibly to connect directly to Queens by bus from La Guardia, if your accommodation is located there.

Vancouver

Your journey will depend on the location of your accommodation. Once you have booked accommodation with us, the school office can give you details to help you plan your journey.

From Vancouver airport, you can take the 'Canada Line' SkyTrain to downtown Vancouver, which takes just 30 minutes. From downtown Vancouver, you can take local transportation (SkyTrain, bus or SeaBus) to your accommodation.
