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2. The school takes bookings for trips on Saturdays and Sundays. These are					
organised by an external company, and St Giles staff do not normally go on					
these trips.

3. All students aged 16 and 17 are advised to have a return airport taxi					
transfer, unless they are travelling with a named relative or adult friend.					
We advise this in order to avoid possible problems with immigration					
procedures. Students must also carry the Parental Travel Consent					
Form.					

School and host family rules:

- 4. Our child must attend all classes, and be on time for each class. The school has a strict attendance policy. Students can be absent only when they are unwell. In such cases, the student or their host family must telephone the school as soon as possible on the day of the illness
- 5. We understand that the school reserves the right to terminate the course of any student who seriously or persistently misconducts himself/herself at the school or in the homestay during his/her stay. In such cases, there will be no refund of fees, and we will be responsible for our child's return or onward journey and the associated costs.

Such misconduct may include: possession/consumption of illegal drugs/alcohol; intentional damage of school or host family property; repeated absence from classes; repeated disturbance of classes or in the host family; repeated breaking of school rules; criminal activity.
